### *The General Assembly*

**Noting with deep concern** that as of December of 2005, 23.7 million people were displaced in the world,

**Emphasizing** that during the war in Yugoslavia, 60,000 refugees lived on the Dalmatian Coast in Croatia,

**Alarmed by** the fact that, as of June 30, 2005, there were 102,000 refugees from Croatia living in Serbia and Montenegro,

**Fully aware** that up to 250,000 Columbian citizens are displace due to drug trafficking routes every year,

**Deeply disturbed** that 16 individual governments throughout the world directly or indirectly displaced people in 2005.

1. **Calls upon** the United Nations to join together and provide increased economic aid for host countries with a high population of refugees;
2. **Recommends** that member nations fund and cooperate with United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees' plan to help southeastern European countries with their refugee problems;
3. **Draws attention** to Columbia and asks the General Assembly to provide funds to aid Columbia, so that they can increase security and resistance to drug trafficking;
4. **Encourages** the UNHCR to meet its goals of having 12,000 refugees returned to Croatia from Serbia and Montenegro;
5. **Emphasizes** the need for the UNHCR to increase the assistance it gives the returning refugees above the current 20%.
