UN Committee: Global Summit on Environmental Sustainability

Topic: Renewable Energy

Sponsor: Pakistan

The General Assembly,

Alarmed by the increasing amount of fossil fuels being used,

Aware of the new global awareness of the role that fossil fuels play in climate change,

Taking into account the need for energy in many developing countries and rural areas, as well as the additional cost that may stem from creating alternative energy sources,

Seeking alternative renewable energy sources:

1. Recommends the creation of a global alternative energy fund, which would assist willing developing countries in receiving the funds necessary for the implementation of alternative energy strategies;
2. Suggests that the money for the fund be taken from a global tax, which would be placed on companies that help produce or sell fossil fuels;
3. Further suggests that companies running predominantly on renewable energy be exempt;
4. Requests that this fund be controlled by a committee that each member state's representatives are determined by:
 - a. The country's need for energy;
 - b. The country's willingness to participate in switching to alternative energy;

5. Urges companies with large carbon emissions to experiment with alternative energy sources in the hope of transitioning into an age of cleaner energy.
