UN Committee: Global Summit on Environmental Sustainability

Topic: Renewable Energy

Sponsor: The Republic of Korea

The General Assembly,

Noting with concern that the world's supply of finite energy resources are dwindling,

Seeking to end the conflicts resulting from the need for energy sources,

Having adopted measures to incorporate solar power plants capable of producing up to 1.2 megawatts of power for the power grid of the Republic of Korea:

1. Congratulates all nations that now receive 1/4 of power through renewable resources, such as the Republic of Iceland;
2. Supports all nations that have taken steps to move from the dependency of non-renewable resources;
3. Calls upon all able nations to begin the construction of solar power plants;
4. Requests that all developed nations take the lead in providing funding for solar power plant construction and management in third world nations;
5. Encourages these developed nations to help fund ongoing projects pertaining to solar power in East Asia;
6. Condemns the Russian Federation, the People's Republic of China, and Japan, along with all other nations whose aggressive oil consumption per capita outranks that of hundreds of nations' combined;

7. Further requests that all nations with aggressive oil consumption per capita begin creating plans to decrease their respective usages;
8. Urges all nations with oil expenditure reduction plans to begin the implementations of these plans on a larger scale.
