Topic: U.N. Security Council Reform

Sponsor: Myanmar

The General Assembly,

Observing that there are only five permanent members of the Security Council and that many areas of the world are underrepresented,

Deeply concerned about the inequality of the Security Council,

Taking into account that Myanmar is located in Southeast Asia,

Recognizing that Southeast Asia does not have permanent representation on the Security Council:

1. Urges the addition of permanent members to the Security Council;
2. Suggests that these new members not have veto power;
3. Recommends that there be at least one member from each region of the world;
4. Endorses India, a powerful nation of Southeast Asia, being added as a permanent member.
