Topic: Girl Child

Sponsor: Greece

The General Assembly,

*Bearing in mind* that men used to be the only citizens that had educational, voting, and political rights in the majority of countries,

*Deeply regretting* that, throughout history, families did not express an equal desire for girl children,

*Commending* Greece for recognizing sexism as unjust after years of believing in non-equality of gender,

*Noting with approval* that Greece and Albania created the “Transnational Action against Child Trafficking” (TACT), a comprehensive, coordinated project to put an end to child trafficking to and from the two countries,

*Recognizing* that all children deserve the chance to develop without terror and fear of attack, theft, rape, or other damaging occurrences in their own society,

1. Calls upon the Departments or Ministries of Education in all countries to supply sufficient restrooms for all students attending their schools;
2. Encourages the creation of laws preventing early and immature marriage before the age of eighteen;
3. Emphasizes the government taking care to eliminate prostitution trafficking;
4. Expresses its appreciation towards Ukraine on making an amendment of Article 124(1) on March 24, 1998 to further label prostitution as intolerable;
5. Further requests Greece to create laws to protect young females from incidents of torture as mock execution and inhuman or degrading treatment;
6. Enforces guardians to be held responsible for their young girls, and all young children for that matter;
7. Implores that the government of Greece assigns more officials to take measures to make sure that fair treatments for young females are established.
