The General Assembly,

Taking into account that in certain societies around the world good nutrition and healthcare is provided primarily for the sons of families before the daughters,

Recognizing Article Two of the Convention on the Rights of the Child stating that all types of discrimination, including sexual discrimination, violates a child's fundamental rights,

Further recalling the Convention on the Rights of the Child, Article Twenty Four, stating that every child has the right to healthcare and good nutrition,

1. Urges those in societies where girls suffer from malnutrition due to gender discrimination to recognize that all beings are created as equals and not only require, but deserve equal care and treatment;
2. Emphasizes the equal spread and distribution of family rations and health privileges;
3. Calls upon the leaders and governments of the nations where gender discrimination causes health and malnutrition problems in young girls to seek out the areas where malnutrition is most occurring and to provide good nutrition and healthcare to the families who need it.
