The General Assembly,

Deeply concerned that sixty percent of the one hundred forty million children not attending school are female,

Alarmed by the fact that seventy-five percent of girls ages fifteen and older are anemic, which can reduce mental performance when left untreated,

Deeply disturbed that forty-eight percent of women in southern Asia are forced to marry before age eighteen,

1. Calls upon countries to make primary school education more widely accessible with relevant curriculum to girls;
2. Urges impoverished countries to make healthcare more affordable and accessible to treat anemia;
3. Encourages countries, especially in southern Asia, to outlaw child marriage and enforce it strictly.
