Subject: Global Warming

The General Assembly

Fully alarmed that by 2100 the sea level is estimated to raise a total of 5-20 inches,

Reminding all countries that many species in the rain forest are close to becoming extinct,

Noting with deep concern that Earth is the warmest it has been in thousands of years,

Recalling the breakup of the Larsen B Ice Shelf and the possibility of this happening again,

Deeply regretting that human activity is the main cause of global warming,

1. Urges countries to pledge 0.03% of their GDP to support organizations that fight against global warming;
2. Requests that all countries pledge 0.05% of their GDP to support and maintain rainforests;
3. Calls upon countries that have not signed the Kyoto Protocol to do so;
4. Encourages all countries to convert to cleaner power such as solar power or hydroelectricity thus reducing their reliability on types of power that cause more pollution;
5. Recommends all countries provide incentives to their major car companies to increase production of hybrid cars by 10%.
